## WHO WE ARE

- The European Centre of Excellence for Civilian Crisis Management (CoE) is an international European organisation based in Berlin. The CoE officially opened its doors in September 2020.
- The CoE currently has 21 members, which are EU Member States. The Centre works closely with the European External Action Service and also partners with NATO.
- The CoE team consist of Seconded National Experts and permanent staff that support their work. Director Volker Jacoby leads the Centre.

## WHAT WE DO

- The main mission of the CoE is to support its members in their efforts to strengthen civilian crisis management in the framework of the EU Common Security and Defence Policy (CSDP).
- The CoE concentrates on 11 defined priorities, among them national systems and frameworks of secondment, embedding work for EU crisis management into the careers of civil servants and other experts, strategic communication, gender mainstreaming, and improving cooperation between civilian CSDP and Justice and Home Affairs.

## HOW WE DO IT

- Identifying and analysing good practices and existing challenges with regards to members' work on implementing their commitments under the EU's civilian CSDP Compact.
- Facilitating exchange in various formats among members with similar needs, challenges, and aspirations, augmented by the Centre's analysis.
- Supporting members in a tailored fashion in their implementation of identified good practices.
